


Dear Valued Stakeholders,

MOH DONATES AMBULANCE TO UGMC

The Ministry of Health (MOH) generously donated an ambulance to the Centre on 20th May, 2024. This donation will significantly enhance our service delivery.



FIRST HUMAN DEMO ON THE NANOX ARC

UGMC successfully conducted its first human demo on the Nanox ARC, a cutting-edge medical imaging technology on 17th January, 2024. Nanox ARC (a cross between a CT scan and an Xray machine) involves the use of medical imaging technology to make diagnostic medicine more accessible and affordable to all. This milestone marks a significant step in our mission to provide innovative healthcare solutions in Ghana and across the globe.



FILLING OF KEY VACANT POSITIONS

The elevation of the Director of Medical Affairs to the position of CEO and the retirement of our former Director of Pharmacy respectively created vacancies in 2023, which needed to be filled. 
